Uniform and Dress Code Policy

The purpose of our school's dress code is to enhance the learning environment by promoting school safety and positive behavior. Pride in one's appearance is the first step in gaining self-esteem and confidence. Limiting distractions associated with inappropriate dress promotes a positive learning environment.

General Guidelines

These general guidelines are to be followed on a daily basis. Final decisions on what is acceptable are made by the administration.

Girls K-4

- Solid white, hunter green or black button down/polo shirts or blouses
- Solid green or plaid skirts and jumpers
- Socks and tights must be blue, black or white
- Solid blue or black leggings are permitted under skirts
- Shoes are black or brown canvas or dress shoes
- Sweaters are hunter green, blue or black
- Ties are optional but encouraged on "Dress for Success" Wednesdays

Girls 5-8

- Solid white, hunter green or black button down/polo shirts or blouses
- Solid green or plaid skirts
- Socks and tights must be blue, black or white
- Solid blue or black leggings are permitted under skirts
- Shoes are black or brown canvas or dress shoes
- Sweaters are hunter green, blue or black
- Ties are optional but encouraged on "Dress for Success" Wednesdays

Boys K-8

- Solid hunter green or black long or short sleeve polo shirts
- White button-down shirts with ties are encouraged for "Dress for Success" Wednesdays
- Khaki pants
- Shoes are black or brown canvas or dress shoes
- Sweaters are hunter green, blue or black

NOT Permitted (including dress down days)

- Hoodies and jackets
- Crocs, flip flops, Ugg slides or boots
- Ripped jeans or pants

**Parents will be contacted and must bring a change of clothing if a student is out of uniform. The student's dress code is an important part of the school's program and philosophy. In making the choice to attend this school; the student with parent support, agrees to follow all dress code requirements. Failure to abide by the dress code policy is in violation of the school's Code of Conduct.
